Personal identifying information is used only for our legitimate business interests, including complying with applicable laws and regulations. We may also use your information to contact you with relevant information from time to time.

From time to time, we will also provide aggregate statistics about our customers, sales, online traffic patterns and related information to reputable third parties, but these statistics will not include any personally identifying or medical information.

Personal information will only be used for the purpose to which it is relevant and has been collected for unless:

- You have given your permission to use the information for other purposes
- The information is used to prevent or lessen a serious threat to your life or health, or that of any other person
- The use of the information is required by law or in the enforcement of the law

When personal information is used, Destination Riverland will take reasonable steps to ensure the information is accurate, complete and up to date.

Destination Riverland will not disclose personal information about you to another person unless

- You have allowed us to disclose the information
- The SATC believes the disclosure is necessary to prevent or lessen a serious threat to life or health
- Disclosure is required by law or in the enforcement of the law or in the enforcement of law
