Itinerary Just over the Blanchetown Bridge, the first Riverland Winery to greet you is **Burke Salter Wines**. Then make sure you call ahead and drop in to **Caudo Vineyard** near Cadell for some wine-tasting, a Sangria or Hogwash Ale and a beautiful view of the river. Head on towards Barmera and marvel at the view from **Banrock Station Wine and Wetland Centre**, where you can enjoy wine tasting, a local lunch and a relaxing wetland walk. Head towards Berri, and call in to the largest winery in the Southern Hemisphere — the **Berri Estates Winery** cellar door. Just around the corner is award winning **919 Wines** (make sure to call ahead if travelling there on a Monday or Tuesday) who specialise in alternative varieties and then head on over the Berri Bridge to family owned **Salena Estate** cellar door on your way to Loxton. We keep coming back to the locally farmed Murray Cod at the **Loxton Community Hotel** – a perfect way to finish a day of savouring local brews, where you can also purchase locally grown **Jachmann Cider**.
